

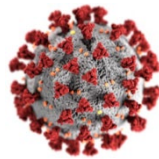

Harlingen to Begin Offering Pediatric Pfizer Vaccine to Children 5-11



Harlingen, Texas—The City of Harlingen will begin administering the Pediatric Pfizer Vaccine to children five to 11 years old on Friday, November 5. Parents/guardians will have to fill out and sign a consent form. The parent or guardian does not need to be present during the child's vaccination once they provide consent. Like the adult vaccine, the pediatric vaccine is a two-dose vaccine three weeks apart.

The vaccine clinic will be held at the City's Health Department located at the Lon C. Hill Building at 502 E. Tyler from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Pfizer, Moderna, and Johnson & Johnson vaccines and boosters will also be available.

Pfizer Vaccine

- 1st & 2nd dose for 12 & older

Pfizer Booster (6-months after initial series)

- 65 and older

- 18 and older with underlying medical conditions
- 18 and older who work or live in high-risk settings.

Moderna Vaccine

- 1st & 2nd dose 18 and older

Moderna Booster (6-months after initial series)

- 65 and older
- 18 and older with underlying medical conditions
- 18 and older who work or live in high-risk settings

Johnson & Johnson Vaccine

- 1st dose 18 and older

Johnson & Johnson Booster (2-months after the initial vaccine)

- 18 and older

Pediatric Pfizer Vaccine

- 5 to 11 years old

An appointment is not needed to get the vaccine/booster
