

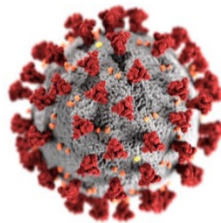



Harlingen Will Hold Vaccine/Booster Clinics This Week



Harlingen, Texas—The City of Harlingen will hold two vaccine clinics this week. The City's Health Department will administer the vaccines and boosters at the Lon C. Hill Building located at 502 E. Tyler on Wednesday, November 3, and Friday, November 5. Pfizer, Moderna, and Johnson & Johnson Vaccines and boosters will be available from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

1st & 2nd Doses
Pfizer 12— older / Moderna 18—older

Boosters
Pfizer —65 & older, 18 & older w/underlying medical conditions
Moderna 18 & older w/underlying medical conditions
& you may qualify for a \$50 gift card for getting 1st vaccine.

Pfizer Vaccine

- 1st & 2nd dose for 12 & older

Pfizer Booster (6-months after initial series)

- 65 and older
- 18 and older with underlying medical conditions
- 18 and older who work or live in high-risk settings

Moderna Vaccine

- 1st & 2nd dose 18 and older

Moderna Booster (6-months after initial series)

- 65 and older
- 18 and older with underlying medical conditions
- 18 and older who work or live in high-risk settings

Johnson & Johnson Vaccine

- 1st dose 18 and older

Johnson & Johnson Booster (2-months after the initial vaccine)

- 18 and older

No appointment is needed but people will have to go inside the building to get the shots. People getting a 2nd vaccine or booster should remember to bring their vaccine cards.

The City is prepared to begin administering vaccines to children 5 and older as soon as the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and the State of Texas provide the guidelines.
