On November 24th 2021, Christy Martinez (27) was reported missing by her family. During the course of the investigation, Harlingen Major Crimes investigators along with the Texas Rangers, and US Marshalls followed up on leads in the case. On 12/4/2021, the deceased body of Christy Martinez was located in a remote location off of Jimenez Rd. in Cameron County.

With information gathered during this case, investigators placed 21-year-old Isaac Vasquez into custody and charged him with Murder and Tampering with Evidence. This case is still an open and evolving investigation at this time.

Isaac Vasquez has been arraigned on the charges and received a One Million Dollar Bond for the charge of Murder, and a One Hundred Thousand Dollar Bond for the charge of Tampering with Evidence.
