MAJOR CRASH UPDATE / ARREST

On 12/11/2021, A Harlingen Police Officer attempted to stop a white in color passenger car. The white passenger car failed to stop and fled from the Officer. The vehicle lost control and crashed at the 1300 block of South Commerce St. The male driver later identified as 21-year-old Jeremy Rodriguez fled the scene of the crash leaving behind his severely injured infant son who was immediately transported to a nearby hospital. The infant child succumbed to injuries and was pronounced deceased at the hospital. The identity of the child is being withheld at this time. This case is still an open and active investigation.

Jeremy Daniel Rodriguez was arraigned by a Harlingen Municipal Court Judge on the following charges.

MURDER - BOND - \$900,000.00

EVADING ARREST / DETENTION - BOND - \$35,000.00

UNLAWFUL CARRYING of FIREARM - BOND - \$5,000.00
