As part of the Texas Department of Transportation's "Drive Sober. No Regrets" Campaign for the holidays, Harlingen Police Department, and law enforcement officers across Texas will increase DWI patrols to identify and stop impaired drivers.

The Harlingen PD Highway Enforcement Unit was set up at Walmart this morning, handing out information and speaking to the public regarding the consequences of drunk driving and our upcoming DWI enforcement wave beginning this Friday, December 17, 2021, and running through January 1, 2022.

Drive Sober. No Regrets. is a key component of [#EndTheStreakTX](#), a broader social media and word-of-mouth effort that encourages drivers to make safer choices while behind the wheel, like wearing a seat belt, driving the speed limit, never texting and driving and never driving under the influence of alcohol or other drugs.
