Harlingen to Resume Vaccine Clinics This Week

Harlingen, Texas—The City of Harlingen is kicking off the New Year with two scheduled COVID-19 Vaccine Clinics. These will be the first clinics for the City since the holidays. The City Health Department will administer the vaccines and boosters at the Lon C. Hill Building located at 502 East Tyler on Wednesday, Jan 5 from 1-7 p.m. and on Friday, Jan 7 from 9 a.m. – 3 p.m.
