Harlingen to Canvass Votes and Swear-In Mayor-Elect

HARLINGEN, Texas—The Harlingen City Commission will meet on Wednesday, May 18, 2022, to canvass the votes from the May 7, 2022, Municipal General & Special Election. The official vote count is required to certify the election. The purpose is to account for every ballot cast and ensure that every vote cast is included in the election totals.

The canvassing is scheduled for 5:30 p.m. at Harlingen City Hall and will be followed by the swearing-in of Mayor-Elect Norma Sepulveda.

More than 25,000 ballots were cast in the City election for Mayor, Commissioner District 1, Commissioner District 2, and three propositions.

During the meeting, the Commission will also consider holding a run-off election on June 14, 2022, to determine the winner in the race for District 1 and District 2 since none of the candidates received a simple majority of votes. The candidates for the District 1 Run-off are Ford Kinsley with 451 votes and Richard Uribe with 432 votes. The candidates for District 2 are Daniel Nemecio Lopez with 345 votes and Ernesto Cisneros with 225 votes.
