Special Meeting Called to Canvass Run-Off Election Votes and Swear-in Two Commissioner Elects

HARLINGEN, Texas– The Harlingen City Commission will meet on June 23, 2022, to canvass the votes for the June 14 Special Run-Off Election. More than 1700 people participated in the necessary run-off to select a City Commissioner for Districts 1 and 2.

In District 1, Ford Kinsley received more votes than Richard Uribe and in District 2 Daniel Lopez received more votes than Ernesto Cisneros. The City Commission will now canvass the votes and make the results official as required by law.

The Special Meeting is scheduled for 5:30 p.m. at Harlingen City Hall. Once the votes are canvassed, Commissioner Elect Kinsley and Commissioner Elect Lopez will be sworn in.
