### **Harlingen to Distribute 1,000 Wristbands Today for another 1<sup>st</sup> Dose Vaccine Clinic**

**Harlingen, Texas**—The City of Harlingen will hold a drive-thru COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic on March 19, 2021, at the Harlingen Convention Center from 6 a.m. - 12 p.m. This clinic is for people aged 50 and older and 18 and older with underlying conditions.

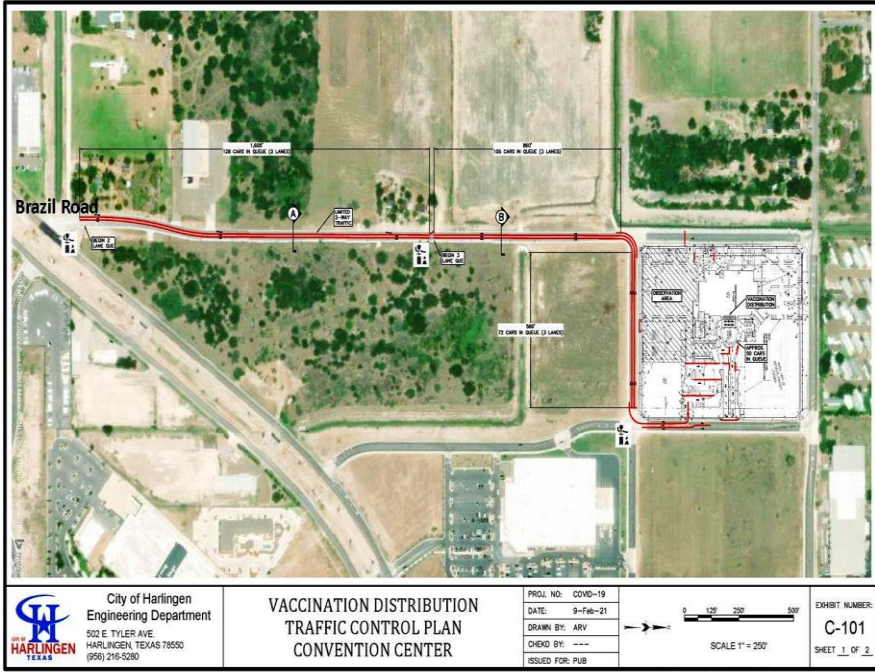
A wristband is required and can be obtained today, Thursday, March 18 at the Harlingen Convention Center located at 701 Harlingen Heights Drive. The wristbands will be distributed beginning at 8 a.m. until they run out.

The City of Harlingen has again partnered with Cameron County Public Health, Valley Baptist Hospital, South Texas Emergency Care Foundation, and the Harlingen Consolidated Independent School District to administer 1,000 first doses of the Moderna COVID-19 Vaccine. This is the third clinic for the City so far since partnering with the County to host and administer the vaccines.

The administration of the doses will be done in two sessions tomorrow—an early morning session from 6-9 a.m. and a mid-morning session from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

People aged 50 and older and 18 and older with underlying conditions with a wristband are guaranteed a vaccine on Friday, March 19 so there is no need to line up the day before and no overnight parking will be permitted.

Access to the Harlingen Convention Center for today’s wristband distribution and Friday’s clinic will be through Brazil Road off of Spur 54.

As a reminder, Brazil Road will be closed to through traffic until 5 a.m. on Friday to discourage overnight parking.

be distributed today beginning at 8 a.m. at the Harlingen Convention Center which is located at 701 Harlingen Heights Drive.
