## Harlingen to Administer 2<sup>nd</sup> Dose Vaccines This Week

**Harlingen, Texas**—The City of Harlingen will hold a 2<sup>nd</sup> dose drive-thru COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic on March 26, 2021, at the Harlingen Convention Center (HCC) from 6 a.m. - 12 p.m. This clinic is for people who received the first dose of the Moderna Vaccine on February 26 at HCC.

The administration of these 2<sup>nd</sup> doses will again be done at HCC in two sessions. The first will be from 6 – 9 a.m. for those that had a blue wristband and from 9 a.m. – 12 p.m. for those that had a red wristband. Everyone will need the vaccine card issued to them on the 26.

There is no need to line up early as the 1000 people vaccinated on Feb. 26 at HCC are guaranteed a second dose. Access to HCC will be through Brazil Road off of Spur 54. Brazil Road will be closed to through traffic until 5 a.m.

This clinic is the result of a partnership between the City of Harlingen, Cameron County Public Health, Valley Baptist Hospital, and the Harlingen Consolidated Independent School District.

Again, this clinic is only for the people who received the first dose at HCC on February 26 as the vaccine card indicates.
