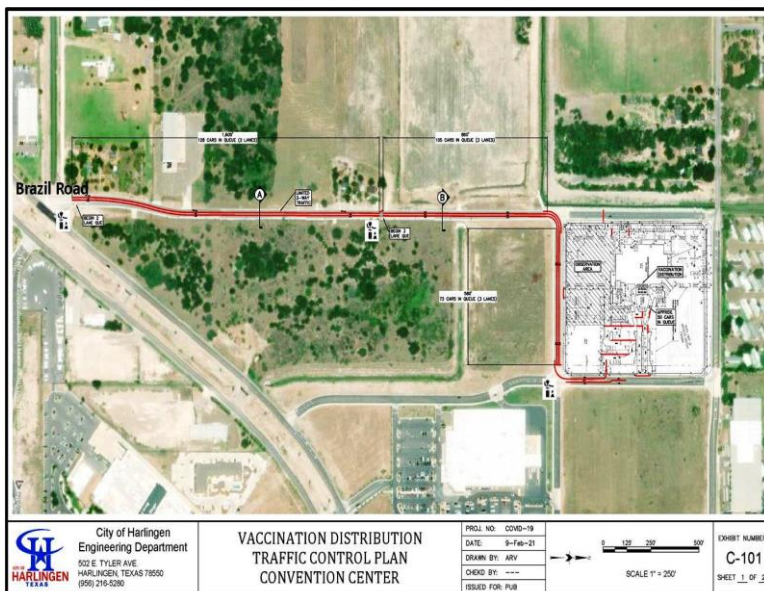

Harlingen to Host 2nd Dose COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic

Harlingen, Texas—The City of Harlingen will hold a 2nd dose drive-thru COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic on March 12, 2021. This clinic is only for the 1000 people that received the first dose of the Moderna Vaccine at the Harlingen Convention Center on February 12.

The administration of the doses will again be done at the Harlingen Convention Center in two sessions. The first will be from 6 – 9 a.m. for those that had a yellow wristband and from 9 – 12 p.m. for those that had a green wristband. The vaccine card issued on February 12 is required. If you lost the card, you can still get the vaccine but it will take longer as the information will have to be verified electronically.

There is no need to line up early as each of the 1000 people is guaranteed a second dose.



Access to the Harlingen Convention Center will be through Brazil Road off of Spur 54. No overnight parking will be permitted and Brazil Road will be closed until 5 a.m. Everyone must be lined up no later than 10 a.m.

The Harlingen Convention Center is located at 701 Harlingen Heights Drive.
