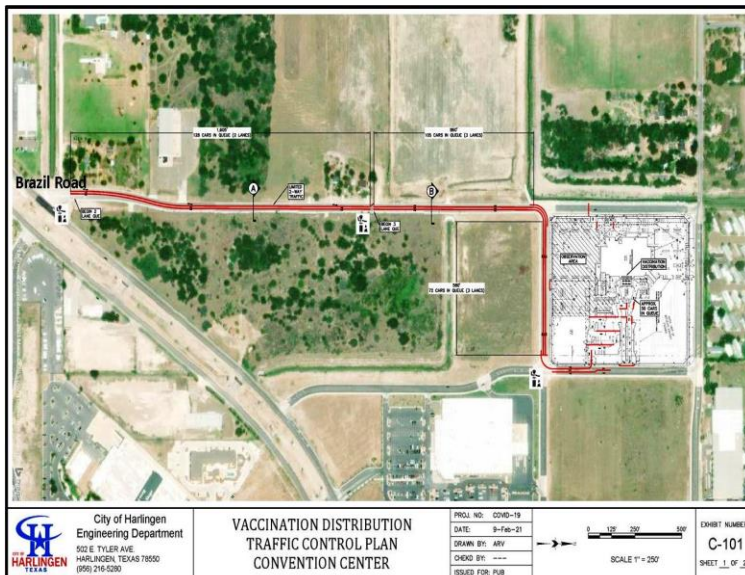

Harlingen to Hold Pfizer Vaccination Clinic for Area High School Students & Community

Harlingen, Texas—The City of Harlingen will hold a drive-thru COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic to administer more than 2000 Pfizer Vaccines at the Harlingen Convention Center (HCC) on Friday, April 23, 2021. The Pfizer Vaccine is available to all persons 16 years of age and older. The doses will be administered between 6 a.m. – 3 p.m. on a first-come-first-served basis.

Wristbands, IDs, medical insurance, nor proof of residency are required to receive these free vaccines. Friday’s clinic is open to the general public.

Several school districts including the Harlingen Consolidated Independent School District have already made arrangements to have at least 1,000 sixteen and older students vaccinated. Students who have not registered through their school district are welcome with an adult who can sign their consent forms. City staff will be available to assist in filling out the consent forms in English and Spanish.



Access to the Harlingen Convention Center for Friday’s clinic will be through Brazil Road off of Spur 54.

As a reminder, Brazil Road will be closed to through traffic until 5 a.m. on both days to discourage overnight parking.
