**CAMERON COUNTY TO HOLD TWO SECOND DOSE ONLY  
COVID-19 VACCINATION CLINICS**

Cameron County will host two second dose COVID-19 vaccination clinics this week only for those individuals that were vaccinated at Cameron County's COVID-19 vaccination clinic sites held four weeks ago. Those individuals that were vaccinated on Wednesday, January 13, 2021, at the Los Fresnos Fire Department will be administered the second dose of the Moderna vaccine at the same location on Wednesday, February 10, 2021, and those individuals that were vaccinated on Friday, January 15, 2021, at the Brownsville Sports Park will be administered the second dose of the Moderna vaccine at the same location on Friday, February 12, 2021.

Both vaccination clinics will begin at 6:00 a.m. and all individuals must be in line no later than 12:00 p.m. All individuals are asked to please arrive with the COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card given at the first vaccination clinic, remain in your vehicle upon arrival, and attend the second dose vaccination clinic as you may be at risk of losing your second dose allocation.

Cameron County has partnered with different entities, cities, and school districts throughout the County for continued vaccination allocation and administration efforts and will provide additional first and second dose vaccination clinic updates as allocations are confirmed. Cameron County Public Health is dedicated to administering the COVID-19 vaccines in accordance with the guidance from the State of Texas and the CDC.
