**CAMERON COUNTY TO HOLD MASS VACCINATION CLINIC AND ALLOCATE  
FIRST AND SECOND-DOSE MODERNA VACCINES TO PRIMARY HEALTH CARE  
DOCTOR'S OFFICES, PHARMACIES, AND MUNICIPALITIES**

Cameron County will host a mass COVID-19 vaccination clinic on Thursday, March 25, 2021, at the Los Fresnos Fire Department located at 100 Rodeo Dr. in Los Fresnos. The Moderna Vaccine will be administered to individuals within the Phase 1A, 1B, and 1C priority groups.

As a reminder, Phase 1A guidelines include front-line health care workers and residents at long-term care facilities, 1B guidelines include individuals 65 years of age or older and persons 18 years of age or older with at least one chronic medical health condition, and 1C guidelines include individuals 50 through 64 years of age.

A limited number of vouchers will be available for pick-up starting today, Tuesday, March 23, 2021, at 5:00 p.m. or tomorrow, March 24, 2021, at 8:00 a.m. at the Cameron County Commissioner Precinct Warehouses below:

Cameron County Public Health in partnership with area school districts in Cameron County will administer the vaccines.

Cameron County Public Health continues to work with area municipalities, medical providers, and pharmacies throughout the County and this week allocated a limited number of first-dose Moderna Vaccines to the Cities of Los Fresnos and Santa Maria, and second-dose allocations to the Cities of Brownsville, Harlingen, Port Isabel, Primera, and Santa Rosa.
