Cameron County Confirms Additional COVID-19 Cases

Cameron County has also received confirmation of an additional ten (10) reports of COVID-19. This includes the following:

This raises the total number of cases to 376 in Cameron County. Of the 376 cases, 163 individuals have recovered.

Cameron County Public Health continues to work with the two nursing home facilities in addressing the COVID-19 outbreaks. To date, the Cameron County cases arising from the Veranda Nursing Home has included 31 employees and 58 residents who have tested positive, including nine (9) who have passed away. There have also been 52 employees and 41 residents who have tested negative. The Windsor Atrium currently has 31 employees and 26 residents who have tested positive, including four (4) who have passed away. There have also been eight (8) employees and three (3) residents who have tested negative.

As part of the COVID-19 action response plan, Cameron County Public Health is conducting epidemiological investigations, contact tracing as needed, and continues to monitor the situation.
