



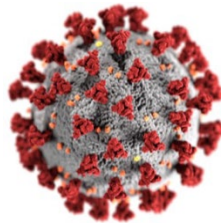

UPDATED to include 65 and Older

Harlingen to Hold Vaccination Clinic for 1st, 2nd, & 3rd Dose This Saturday



Harlingen, Texas—The City of Harlingen along with Valley Baptist Medical Center Harlingen, South Texas Emergency Care Foundation, University of Texas Rio Grande Valley, and the Harlingen Consolidated Independent School District will hold a drive-thru COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic to administer more than 2000 available vaccines at the Harlingen Convention Center (HCC) on Saturday, September 25, 2021. Pfizer and Moderna vaccines will be available. The Pfizer Vaccine is available to all persons 12 years of age and older for the 1st and 2nd doses. The 3rd dose is available for folks 65 and older, people 18 and older with underlying medical conditions, and those who are at increased risk for exposure such as first responders.

The Moderna Vaccine is available to people 18 and older for the 1st and 2nd dose. The third dose is available to people with immunocompromised conditions.

The City COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic will run from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. on a first-come-first-served basis.

As a reminder, the City of Harlingen's Incentive Program is in effect until October 31, 2021, and provides a \$50 gift certificate to Cameron County residents who get the first dose of any of the available vaccines.
