



COVID-19 Harlingen City Facilities Closed

Following Cameron County's Emergency Order with Mandatory Countywide Shelter in Place and the travel restriction order of March 20, 2020, and the limitation of gatherings of 10 people or less, the City of Harlingen has closed the following facilities.

- Harlingen Housing Authority Offices-closed
- Harlingen Recycling Center- closed
- Downtown Harlingen Office- closed
- Harlingen Public Library –closed
- Museum – closed
- Lon C. Hill Building- permits, birth & death certificates – limited access of fewer than 10 people at a time.
- Harlingen Police Department- front lobby closed
- Municipal Court- closed (Video Conferencing Dockets available)
- Police Records- online only
- City Hall- limited access to less than 10 people at a time.
- Valley International Airport- following CDC recommendations of social distancing.
- Golf Course- closed.
- Swimming pools & Splash Pad- closed
- Parks- closed
- Garage sales canceled.
- City Sponsored events canceled.
- Private events at City facilities canceled.
- City rentals canceled.

These closures could be extended and more facilities could be closed as a pro-active measure to limit the spread of COVID-19.
