**FIRST AMENDED JOINT CAMERON COUNTY HEALTH AUTHORITY AND
CAMERON COUNTY JUDGE EMERGENCY HEALTH CONTROL ORDER
DELAYING IN PERSON FACE-TO-FACE PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOL
INSTRUCTION UNTIL AFTER SEPTEMBER 28, 2020**

Effective August 31, 2020, Cameron County Judge Eddie Trevino, Jr. and the Cameron County Health Authority Dr. James Castillo issue the First Amended Joint Cameron County Health Authority and Cameron County Judge Emergency Health Control Order Delaying In-Person Face-to-Face Public and Private School Instruction until after September 28, 2020, in Order to replace paragraph 5 which indicates that decisions regarding the education and placement of students who are determined to be medically fragile including for remote or face-to-face instruction will be made in accordance with the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act, and Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act as applicable as well as based upon state law and with the participation of school officials and parents.

Furthermore, all school systems, public or private, must develop a plan for re-opening on-campus, face-to-face instruction and activities two weeks prior to September 28, 2020, and provide plans to the Cameron County Health Authority.
