### **Harlingen Partners with CAMCO for Friday 1<sup>st</sup> Dose Vaccination Clinic**

**Harlingen, Texas**—The City of Harlingen and Cameron County will hold a drive-thru COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic on February 12, 2021, at the Harlingen Convention Center from 6 a.m.-3 p.m. This clinic is for people aged 65 and older.

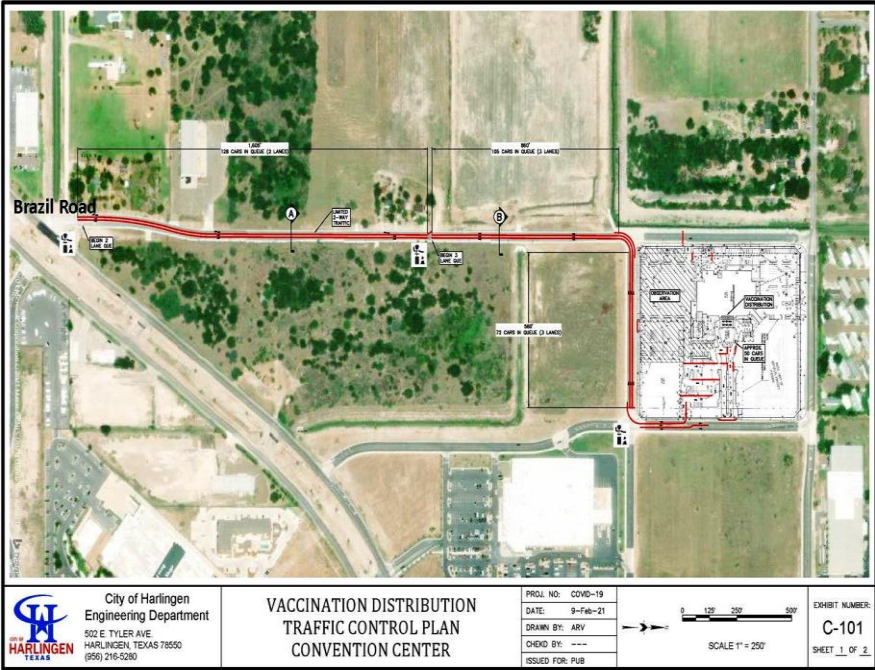
A wristband is required and can be obtained today, Thursday, February 11 at the Harlingen Convention Center located at 701 Harlingen Heights Drive and the City's Emergency Operations Center located at 24200 North FM 509. The wristbands will be distributed beginning at 8 a.m. until they run out and individuals must show an ID verifying the age requirement. These wristbands are not transferable and age will be verified before receiving the vaccine.

The City of Harlingen and Cameron County Public Health have partnered with the Harlingen Consolidated Independent School District to administer 1,000 first doses of the Moderna vaccine.

The administration of the doses will be done in two sessions—a morning session from 6-11 a.m. and an afternoon session from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m.

People aged 65 and older with a wristband are guaranteed a vaccine on Friday, Feb. 12 so there is no need to line up the day before and because of the weather, no overnight parking will be permitted.
