## **Pfizer 2<sup>nd</sup> Dose Vaccine Clinic to Be Held in Harlingen Friday**

**HARLINGEN, Texas**—Almost 900 area high school students are due for their 2<sup>nd</sup> dose of Pfizer this week at the Harlingen Convention Center (HCC). The City has partnered with Valley Baptist Hospital, South Texas Emergency Care Foundation, and HCISD again to ensure that the 870 persons 16 and older that got their first dose on April 23 get their required 2<sup>nd</sup> dose.

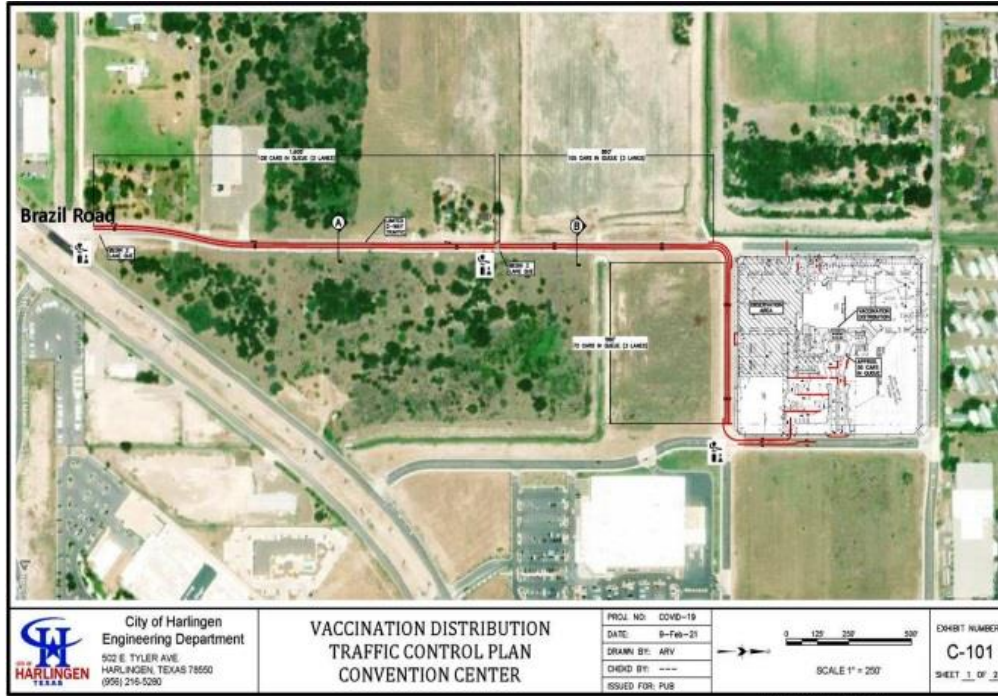
This will be a drive-thru clinic and like the first 16 held in Harlingen, it will start at 6 a.m. and run through noon.

Students from several area high schools were inoculated on April 23 including HCISD, La Feria ISD, and San Benito CISD.

The Pfizer Vaccine is now available for everyone 12 and older and 1<sup>st</sup> doses will also be available on Friday, May 21, 2021, at the Harlingen Convention Center. Parents/responsible adults must accompany persons under 18.

As of January 8, 2021, the City has administered 20,800 vaccines through clinics and another 185 through the City's Homebound Program.
