## **No Mobile Vendor Permits to be issued in Harlingen**

**Harlingen, Texas**– The City of Harlingen announces that mobile vendor permits for Easter will not be issued due to the Executive Orders by Texas Governor Greg Abbott and Cameron County Judge Eddie Trevino, Jr. to Shelter in Place. Code Compliance Officers will patrol and issue citations to violators.

The Shelter in Place Order prohibits people to congregate to stop the spread of COVID-19. This means that people should stay at home unless traveling for essential services such as going to work, the doctor, or buying groceries.

To date, there have been 101 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Cameron County. That's why Judge Trevino yesterday extended the Shelter in Place Order until April 21.

The City of Harlingen strongly encourages residents to abide by the order in the best interest of the community as a whole. Everyone is urged to wear a cloth mask/covering while in public or commercial settings.
