

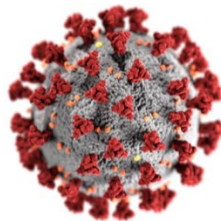

Harlingen to Hold Vaccination Clinic for 1st, 2nd, & Booster This Saturday



Harlingen, Texas—The City of Harlingen along with Valley Baptist Medical Center Harlingen, South Texas Emergency Care Foundation, University of Texas Rio Grande Valley, and the Harlingen Consolidated Independent School District will hold a drive-thru COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic to administer vaccines at the Harlingen Convention Center (HCC) on Saturday, October 23, 2021. Pfizer, Moderna, and Johnson & Johnson Vaccines will be available.

Pfizer Vaccine

- 1st & 2nd dose for 12 & older

Pfizer Booster

- 65 and older
- 18 and older with underlying medical conditions
- People who are at increased risk for exposure such as first responders.

Moderna Vaccine

- 1st & 2nd dose 18 and older
- 3rd dose is available for people with compromised immune systems.

Johnson & Johnson Vaccine

- 1st dose 18 and older

The City COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic will run from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. on a first-come-first-served basis.

As a reminder, the City of Harlingen's Incentive Program is in effect until October 31, 2021, and provides a \$50 gift certificate to Cameron County residents who get the first dose of any of the available vaccines.

Since February 12, 2021, the City of Harlingen has administered 25,162 vaccines.
