Updated Cancellations in Harlingen as Precautionary Measure to Prevent COVID-19

Harlingen, Texas– The City of Harlingen continues to monitor the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) situation along with Cameron County, state, and federal health officials. As always, the safety and well-being of the community are of utmost importance to Harlingen City leaders. Although no cases have been reported in the Rio Grande Valley, we continue to take pro-active measures to help prevent the disease.

Following the recommendations by the Centers for Disease Control and The Texas Department of State Health Services, all City-sponsored events and activities have been canceled or postponed.

Likewise, all private events at City facilities for more than 10 people are canceled or postponed.

Also, starting now, the Harlingen Public Library is closed as is the museum. We encourage patrons to take advantage of all the digital services the library has available to cardholders by visiting <https://harlingenlibrary.org/>.

These closures/cancelations will remain in effect until April 5, 2020, and could be extended if needed.
