Harlingen to Re-open Golf Course with Restrictions

Harlingen, Texas– Following this week’s announcement by Governor Greg Abbott that golf courses are essential to the community and Cameron County Judge Eddie Trevino Jr’s amended order allowing the opening of golf courses with restrictions; the City of Harlingen will re-open the Tony Butler Golf Course at 7 a.m. on Saturday, April 25.

The City will strictly enforce the guidelines recommended by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) of social distancing throughout the course, as well as, the Cameron County requirement of the use of facial coverings/masks while in public.

Tony Butler Current Play Restrictions are as follows:

- Enter through Driving Range side and only one person at a time
- Follow social distancing tape on the ground around the clubhouse
- Check-in and payment accepted at the charging station located at the food counter
- No more than 2 players per tee time
- Face coverings required
- CDC requirement of 6 feet apart will be strictly enforced
- No touching or removing flags during play
- Please arrive no earlier than 15 minutes before your tee time
- Each player will need to have a tee time
- Club rentals will not be available until further notice
- Restaurant and snack bar items will be available for take-out only and orders will be taken at the snack bar window

News From The City of Harlingen

- All water stations have been removed from the golf course
- Only ONE rider per golf cart
- All golf carts will be sanitized before they are placed in the staging area next to Hole 1
- Public spaces within the clubhouse will be closed to all members and guests
- Driving Range will be closed
- No ball washers will be used on the course
- Sand bottles will be removed from the carts
- Alcohol beverages will not be brought onto the course
- All players must leave the course as soon as reasonably possible after play
- NO large group outings or tournaments will be allowed at this time

Again each golfer must have a tee time. The Tony Butler revised hours of operations are 7 a.m. - 5 p.m.

As a reminder, the Cameron County Shelter in Place Order is still in effect and the curfew hours remain 12-5 a.m.
