Life Saving Award



The Harlingen Police Department believes in the recognition of officers, their actions and outstanding efforts in service to the community and their fellow officers. In keeping with this belief, the City of Harlingen, and the Harlingen Police Department recognize Officer Adan Rodriguez Jr. for his outstanding efforts that occurred on June 4th, 2021.

Officer Adan Rodriguez Jr. responded to a disturbance on the 200 block of E. Buchanan St. When Officer Rodriguez arrived at the location, he located a female that had a large laceration to her right arm, and was bleeding profusely. Officer Rodriguez without hesitation, took possession of the Police issued tourniquet and immediately applied it on the injured female slowing the bleeding. Officer Rodriguez kept applying pressure to her raised arm until EMS arrived and transported her to a local hospital.

Therefore, Officer Adan Rodriguez's actions qualify him for this life Saving Award and bestows upon him the departments and the city's appreciation. The Life Saving Award was presented to Officer Rodriguez by Harlingen Police Chief Michael Kester, and Patrol Sergeant Antonio Maldonado.
