On 7/27/2021 at approximately 9:20am, the Harlingen Police Department received a call in reference to a male subject in a vehicle with a gun. Information received was that the vehicle was in a drive-thru of a local business. Officers located the vehicle on the 1800 block of West Tyler, and conducted a traffic stop on it. As officers used caution to approach the subject due to the information that he was armed, the male fled on foot. Officers caught up to the male, and placed him into custody without incident. A search of his vehicle was conducted, and a handgun was located inside. The male was identified as 20 year old Angel Daniel Nordin from San Benito. He was transported to the Harlingen City Jail, and charged with Unlawfully carrying of a Weapon, and Evading Arrest.

Evading Arrest – Class A - \$2,500.00 BOND

Angel Daniel Nordin has been arraigned and remanded to the Cameron County Jail.
