Shooting / Murder Suspect Dead

For the last few days, the Harlingen Police Department has been working diligently to locate and bring Eduardo Zamora to justice for the murder of 28-year-old Destiny Pemelton, and the Aggravated Assaults of two male victims. Earlier today Mexican authorities confirmed that Zamora was killed in a confrontation with Mexican police in Rio Bravo. We are still gathering information from the Mexican authorities and we appreciate their cooperation with us. Our thoughts and prayers go out to the victims of this incident.

Even though the search for Zamora is over, we will continue working on this case. The Harlingen Police Department would like to thank Marshal T. Michael O'Connor, United States Marshals Service, Texas Department of Public Safety, and Cameron County District Attorney Luis V. Saenz office for their assistance and efforts in bringing this tragic incident to a resolution.
