


RESIDENTIAL BRUSH PICK-UP GUIDELINES

- > The city shall provide services for the collection of tree limbs, brush trimmings, garden clippings or other vegetable matter. This service shall not be provided to any <u>vacant lot</u> or unoccupied property within the city.
- > These services are provided once every month.
- Residents with alleys are to place their brush/tree limbs in the alley directly behind the property and should not block any part of the alley way. Brush/tree limbs placement on someone else's property is prohibited.
- Residents with no alley are to place their brush/tree limbs in front of their property by the roadway or street's edge. Brush/tree limbs are not to be placed on any part of the street, sidewalk or are not to block any city storm drain.
- > Brush/tree limbs are not to be placed on any vacant lot.
- > The blowing of grass clippings/leaves/brush/tree limbs onto any street or inside any city storm drain is prohibited. This can cause an obstruction in the storm drains and can lead to poor drainage and possible flooding in your neighborhood.
